The case for investing in AWI delays in discharge

1. AWI delays are 4.9 times longer than a standard delay

61% of people are delayed by more than 100 days

2. Every AWI delay has a bigger impact on the system



Fewer people are able to get planned care

Planned Care

79 cancelled surgeries per average AWI delay ²

There are 81 cancelled surgeries a month²

20% of all cancelled surgeries are due to capacity

Patient anxiety increases during the wait for surgery

Longer waits increase demand for primary and secondary care 4

40% had their health worsen while waiting for planned care ⁵

Emergency Department

Hospital occupancy >92% increases ED wait times due to delayed admission⁶

Every 1% increase in bed occupancy decreases the probability of meeting ED 4hr wait target by 9.5%

For every 82 admitted patients delayed 8+hrs ED, there is 1 extra death 8

Waits 5+hrs increase 30 day mortality rates 8

5-12hr delays cause predictable dose-response effect 8

Ambulances

20% ambulance capacity is lost to delayed handovers 9

Delays in handover lead to ambulance stacking 9 10

9% patients experience potential additional harm and 1% potential severe harm as a result of ambulance handover delays of more than 1hr¹⁰

3. Long hospital stays are harmful to patients' physical and mental health

Leading to deconditioning, hospital acquired infections and distress. Hospitals are not the least restrictive option

4. Addressing AWI delays is good for people and system pressures

This means reducing the number of people admitted to hospital, changing our legislative approach, and ensuring adequate social work and mental health officer capacity embedded within hospital discharge teams who actively manage and coordinate the processes required
